

SHIPS LIST 1816-1820

Civilian Settlers - Perth Military Settlement - The First Five Years

* This list of civilian settlers who received location tickets at the Perth Military Settlement has been created from the transcription of land grants as prepared by Christine Spencer (from National Archives of Canada, MG9, D8-27, Vol. 1, Microfilm Reel #C-4651); ship arrival reports published in the Quebec Gazette, Quebec Mercury and Montreal Gazette, as extracted and posted on 'The Ships List' www.theshipslist.com; the book 'Leinster to Lanark' by Carol Bennett McCuaig (2010), and miscellaneous sources.

* The list comprises 659 names of heads-of-family arriving over the 5-year period between 1816 and 1820 via 134 different ships. It should, however, in no way be considered comprehensive or complete and no doubt contains many errors. The 659 names may represent as many as 3,000 total immigrants (including wives and children).

* These are not full passenger lists, but only include those passengers who received location tickets at Perth. In a very few cases complete or nearly complete passenger lists have survived or have been reconstructed; see 'The Ships List' www.theshipslist.com

* The settlement locations noted for each man are the Township, Concession and Lot number appearing on their original location ticket. There were many exchanges and transfers however and many later moved to a different property.

* Sailing Vessels - A **Ship** has three or more masts with square sails on each mast; a **Bark** or **Barque** has three or more masts with square sails on all masts except the aft or mizzen mast which has a triangular or quadrilateral gaff rigged sail; a **Brig** has two masts with square sails on both masts; a **Brigantine** has two masts with square sails on the fore-mast and triangular or quadrilateral gaff rigged sails on the aft mast; a **Schooner** has two or more masts of equal height, or with the aft mast higher, all rigged with triangular or quadrilateral gaff rigged sails. Vessel types are defined by their rigging, not their size.
